NON-PERISHABLE ITEMS



Donating one or more of the following items from the Community Hero wishlist will be contributed towards the exhibitors award tabulation:

- Eligible items include: paper towels, paper plates (no styrofoam), plastic silverware, laundry detergent, dryer sheets, kleenex, clorox wipes, dishwasher pods, ziploc bags (snack & sandwich), coffee creamer, chapstick, pre-packaged snacks (chips, crackers, cookies, trail mix, popcorn, mac n cheese cups, etc.)
- Gift cards to these local stores are welcome as well: Amazon, Walmart, Target, Fareway, Hy-Vee, and gas stations.
- If arranging delivery of community hero items presents a hardship due to time or distance constraints, please contact your nearest house of choice to discuss arrangements.



3 points per non-perishable item donated and 1 point per dollar of value for each giftcard. Hero's who donate one of each item from the wishlist will receive a bonus 75 points! Help RMH staff prepare by calling your RMH location prior to your arrival and notify staff what the items are for at drop-off.

POP TABS

Help the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Iowa offset expenses such as utility bills, by donating aluminum pop tabs.

Exhibitors will earn: 5 points for 0 to 2 pounds; 10 points for 3 to 5 pounds; and 15 points for 6 to 10 pounds. Approximately 1,128 pop tabs equal one pound. Please weigh your pop tabs and make arrangements to drop off and/or send pop tabs to the nearest Ronald McDonald House location before arriving at the fair. **Pop tabs must be postmarked by August 10. We will also accept pop tabs brought to weigh in on Thursday, August 13.**
